I never saw a police officer all weekend this direction. I saw one young Bicycle Parking Enforcement person come up on S. Spruce St. Saturday at 4:15 and he cycled up the street and never stopped.

At the time he drove by, there were 4 cars parked on 4 separate corners and also multiple cars parked the wrong way on both sides of the street as well. You can see this in the photos. I also believe that the person parked close to the fire hydrant was also there.

I would like to say that usually when I see the bicycle enforcement, they are all hanging out together standing around texting on their phones and standing all together in the parking lot across the street from the VFW hall or at the skate park.

I rarely see them around the neighborhoods and I have never seen them giving out citations to cars that are breaking the law.

Why are we paying parking enforcement officers that never enforce the parking laws in Cannon Beach. That money could be used in a much better way if the enforcement officers do not generate any income and do not make our streets safer due to unsafe parking enforcement.

Also, there was multiple RV's parked up here all weekend. Also an illegal parking situation and I have included those as well.
